- ∂ We received $\underline{0}$ water quality complaints (WQC)
- ∂ We received <u>1</u> consumer/appeal claim(s)
 - This appeal is for 11838 E. Highway 20 in regards to the \$150.00 charged to the account resulting from a delinquent turn off. This appeal is out of the 10-day appeal window from the date of the charges and receipt of the appeal. More details will be shared at the meeting.
- ∂ There are 13 accounts on payment arrangements.
 - We continue to receive payments from the LIHWAP program for past due balances, we are also referring customers to contact the program. To date, we have received \$10,406.00, this amount has prevented services from being shut off and has also restored services.
- ∂ The District continues to conduct its billing audit on vacant lots and unbilled properties within District boundaries. This will be an ongoing audit for an unknown period of time.
- ∂ Write-Offs were processed on 03/08/23, 8 accounts totaling \$159.47
- ∂ Collection reports have been generated, letters will start to go out first week or so of April, after the tax roll is processed. Per County, the check was issued on or about 03/09/23. I'm hoping to receive that along with the payment report in order to process quickly.
- ∂ Backflow letters will go out on 03/13/23, this will be our first year processing over 950 letters.

Water distribution main & service lines:

- We had to replace a service line saddle on Island Circle Drive.
- DC had to move a service line on Konocti Drive using our hot-tap.
- During the district wide power outage due to the snow storm, DC broke into two groups for 12 hour shifts. We set up and maintained generators to keep the sewer and water mains flowing in the district.
- There were four service line repairs made.
- Jesse and I attended a training class on Cla-valves.







Sample station sites/Boil water notices:

- DC crew is still collecting the routine BacT samples every Wednesday. All reports have come back absent for total Coliforms and E.Coli.
- The samples taken for boil water notice on Island Circle Drive where we had to shut down the main to replace a saddle came back absent for total Coliforms and E.Coli.

Sewer collections and Lift station sites:

• There was a plug in the sewer main on Blue Heron, which caused a spill out of the south end manhole. Because of some raw sewage was spilled, a State report was filed. The plug was cleared and is now flowing well.

March 2023 Board letter

- February raw water NTU from the pier intake has increased a little, primarily in the range of 8-12. The PH level has also been increasing up to a high of 9.2. The ammonia levels have dropped again allowing us to drop our chlorine dose back down. Charge analyzer and jar testing are being done regularly; adjustments are being made and monitored to keep up with PH changes.
- ♦ The lake is currently at 5.97 with a heavy rain storm forecasted this week into the weekend
- ♦ Water production for the month of February 2023 was 12.481 MG. Raw water intake is 15.833 MG. Down from February 2022 production of 17.548 MG. The daily range we are producing less than last year is running about 100,000 gallons. Production has been averaging below 450,000 GPD.
- We are still getting regular plant shut downs.
- Treatment has been able to do the weekly tank runs for testing of chlorine residuals in all the tank locations.
- Continuing maintenance / cleanup through the plant area.
- Clarifier 1 has been put back into operation as of 3-8-23 moving forward we will be running with two clarifiers again.
- We had the plant and all tank locations sprayed for weeds on 3-8-23 to help with fire prevention.
- On 3-9-23 we had a bird that hit a power line causing a power failure we ran off generator for about 1.5 hours.
- On 3-13-23 we gave a plant tour for the local college water/distribution class.
- The district had a large power outage due the heavy snow fall the plant ran for 20.5 hours on generator before power was restored to the plant. James and I adjusted our schedules to accommodate someone being at the plant at all times during the outage.

February was a calm month. As seen above the flows to the plant came down from last month. CPM Company has been out to install our effluent pump #2 (as seen in picture) and it has been unsuccessful due to bad communication in their end. It is scheduled to attempt install Monday March 13th.



On February 28th staff conducted Disinfection on both groundwater wells #2 and #3. This consists of adding sodium hypochlorite to the volume of water in the casing. The amount of chlorine added should achieve 150 mg/l of free chlorine. On March 1st, after 24 hours of contact, both wells were purged 'till 0 mg/l of free chlorine was registered. The reason for this process is to eliminate the total coliform detected on previous sampling. The plant at this time is running well. There has been preparation and training in the event of a flooding in District. Again it is appreciated the help and support the board gives.

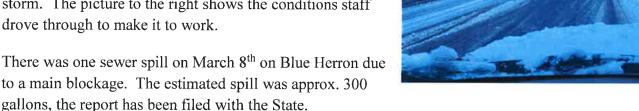
Board of Directors,

As I'm writing this letter the lake level is at +6.38 with more rain in the forecast. I think it is safe to say that we will be heading into summer with a full lake. Great news! I have directed the water operators to continue to rotate all three intake pumps to ensure all pumps continue to operate properly.

The second clarifier is complete and now back on line. All scaffolding has been removed and is nice to have our plant yard back.

The first check from the County Tax Collector is usually received toward the end of February, however, when we did not receive it, I followed up and was assured that the check should go out in the mail within a couple of weeks.

The staff, once again, stepped up to the plate and weathered the snow storm to ensure continued operations when the District lost power. Plant operators along with field staff immediately transferred to back-up power without hesitation and continued to staff the district through-out the storm. The picture to the right shows the conditions staff drove through to make it to work.



I am wrapping up with my first draft of the 2023-2024 budget and I would like to set up a budget meeting on April 6th if everyone is available. I would like to have it on April and Mays' agenda for any comments before submitting for approval at the June meeting.

The first quarter is already wrapping up with Olivia posting the first newsletter of the year this month.

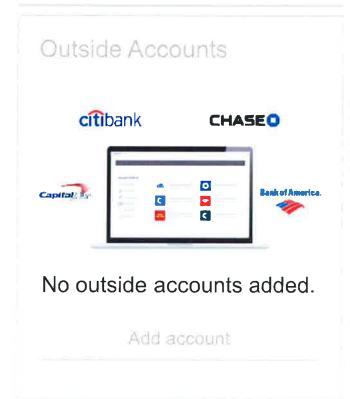
